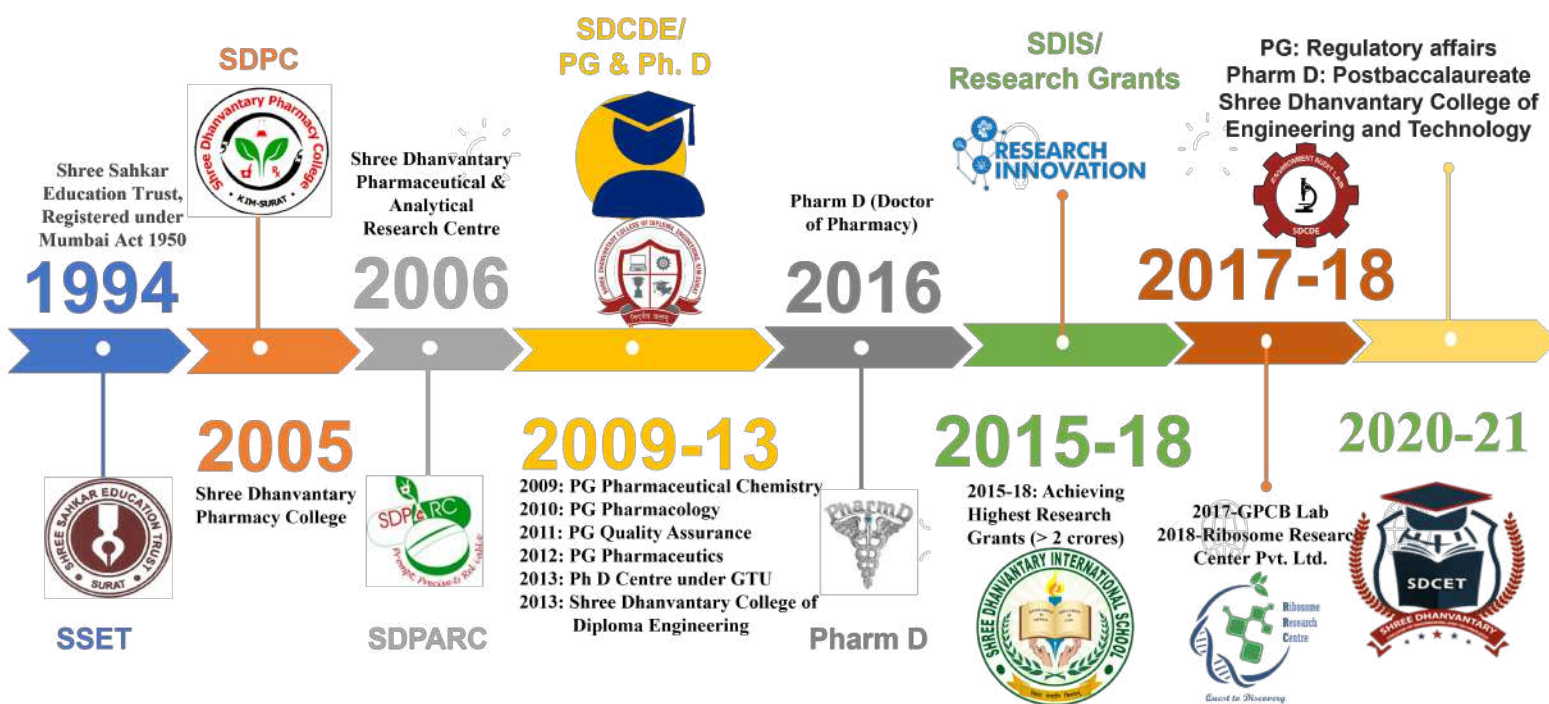


GENESIS



AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into the 1st day of March, 2016 ("Effective Date")

Between

Shree Dhanvantary Pharmacy College, Near Railway station, College Road, Kim, Taluk: Olpad, District: Surat, Gujarat 394110

located in Kim-Surat, Gujarat (hereinafter referred to as "Pharmacy College") which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors-in-interest and permitted assigns, acting through its authorized representative, duly authorized to sign and execute this Agreement of the First Part.

AND

Shri Basavaraj Hoovinabhavi Phd, resident of House # 401, Maruti Apartments, Wing A, Kim (East), Taluk Olpad, District Surat, Gujarat 394110 (hereinafter referred to as "the Research Scientist") of the Second Part;

And

Good Health Private Limited, a company formed and registered under the laws of India having its registered office at Sector 15 A #53, NOIDA, U.P. 201301(hereinafter referred to as "Good Health") which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors-in-interest and permitted assigns, of the Third Part.

WHEREAS

- A. The Pharmacy College wishes to utilize the services of the Research Scientist for teaching and to conduct academic research at its facilities that are equipped for research and would like to make the said facilities available to the Research Scientist.
- B. The Research Scientist is interested in teaching and academic research as well as conducting formulation research.
- C. Good Health wishes to give research grant to enable the Research Scientist to conduct academic research and teaching for Pharmacy College and formulation research for Good Health



For the sake of brevity and convenience, the Pharmacy College, the Research Scientist and Good Health may hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Parties", and individually, as the "Party" as the context may require.

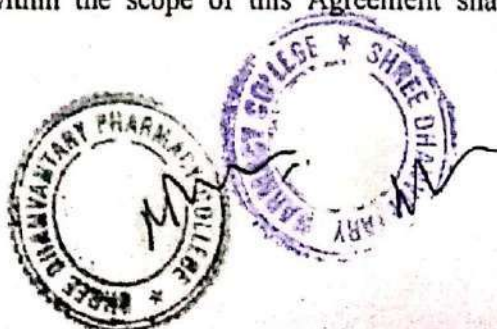
NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, accepted and agreed to, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, agree to the terms set forth below.

1. This Agreement shall be valid for a period of one year commencing from the Effective Date and valid till February 28th, 2017 ("Term") with the option to Good Health to renew the Agreement for two further terms of 12 months each subject to the Research Scientist agreeing to continue to conduct formulation research for Good Health on the same terms and conditions as that of this Agreement..
2. Good Health and Research Scientist will notify the Pharmacy College in writing on or before December 31st every year whether they wish to renew the Agreement for an additional term of one year and thereafter the Agreement will be renewed in writing by the Parties on the following terms.
3. The Pharmacy College and Good Health hereby individually warrant that the execution and performance of this Agreement does not violate their policies or procedures.
4. The Research Scientist shall be responsible for any and all tax liability, as per the applicable laws, for the compensation that he receives from the Pharmacy College.
5. Subject to the provisions of this Agreement, Good Health hereby agrees to pay a research grant of Rs 12 lakhs (Rs. Twelve Lakh) per year to the Pharmacy College to support Research Scientist's research. The research grant shall be paid biannually by Good Health in two equal instalments of Rs. 6 lakhs each for a period of 6 month each commencing from March 1st, 2016.
6. In case the Research Scientist decides to leave for any reason prior to the expiry of the Term of this Agreement, any amount of research fund which has already been remitted by Good Health for the period for which Research Scientist is not engaged to do research shall be refunded/returned to Good Health on a pro-rated basis for the remaining period.
7. During the Term of this Agreement, the Research Scientist shall be engaged in teaching, academic research (not for pharmaceutical formulations) and pharmaceutical product formulation research.
8. It is hereby agreed by the Parties that pharmaceutical product formulation research shall be conducted by the Research Scientist exclusively for Good Health whereas the



teaching, academic research (not for pharmaceutical formulations) shall be undertaken by the Research Scientist for the Pharmacy College.

9. The Research Scientist hereby expressly agrees that he shall neither undertake any research nor will have any involvement, whether directly or indirectly, with any other entity, commercial enterprise, firm etc. without prior express written approval of Good Health. In case any assistance is required, Research Scientist will, however, have the freedom to decide in his sole discretion as to who will be entrusted to participate in his laboratory and formulation research activities.
10. Good Health undertakes to make payment for the materials utilized exclusively for formulation research other than normal laboratory chemicals. It is hereby agreed that Good Health will deposit a sum of Rs. 2.5 lakhs (Rs. Two Lakh Fifty Thousand) for purchasing the materials for formulation research which will be periodically replenished by Good Health as and when required. The facilities and equipment available at the Pharmacy College will be provided without any charge by the Pharmacy College and will be maintained and operated at the Pharmacy College's own cost except that solely for the period when the stability chambers are being exclusively utilized by Good Health, only the electricity charges for the stability chambers will be paid for by Good Health. If they are being used by any party other than Good Health then the Pharmacy College shall be solely responsible to pay electricity and all other charges for the stability chambers as well.
11. Good Health and Pharmacy College hereby agree that both the research grant and the advance against formulation material costs will be deposited in a separate and distinct interest bearing account opened by the Pharmacy College with any nationalized bank and any interest earned on the amounts deposited in the said bank account will be utilized to cover the material costs. Any balance amount left in this bank account at the end of the Term of this Agreement shall be refunded/returned to Good Health within 15 (Fifteen) days of expiry or early termination of this Agreement as the case may be, without any deduction after settling outstanding dues for materials and making the final payment to the Research Scientist.
12. The Invoices and accounting for the formulation materials will be submitted by Research Scientist and the Pharmacy College to Good Health on a monthly basis.
13. It is hereby expressly agreed by the Parties that the formulation research conducted by Research Scientist during the Term of this Agreement including any renewals shall remain the exclusive property of Good Health.
14. The Research Scientist agrees to maintain strict confidentiality and will discuss research finding under this Agreement only with Good Health or its designated representatives. All data, literature, and information in any form, not in the public domain, that is provided to the Research Scientist within the scope of this Agreement shall be considered



proprietary data whether or not it is expressly marked proprietary. For the duration of this Agreement and thereafter, proprietary data shall not be revealed or transferred by Research Scientist to any other person, third party, company or otherwise without prior written authorization of Good Health.

- 15- All Intellectual property developed as a result of the formulations research conducted by Research Scientist shall be the exclusive and undisputed property of Good Health including all raw data, scientific pre-clinical or clinical data, databases, formulations and all related know-how, and all record bearing media containing or disclosing the foregoing information and techniques including patents and patent applications, notes and memoranda, whether in writing or presented, stored or maintained in or by electronic or other means. All concepts and ideas that are either disclosed by Good Health or which are first developed by the Research Scientist or any assistants during the course of the performance of the formulations research under this Agreement shall remain the sole and exclusive property of the Good Health including all publication rights. All parties hereby assign, and to the extent any such assignment cannot be made at present, hereby agree to assign to Good Health, without further compensation all of the right title and interest in and to all Concepts, Ideas and Developments. All parties also agree to execute all necessary document that Good Health considers necessary or advisable to secure its rights to the Formulation and related research conducted under this Agreement and to carry out the intent of this Agreement. *
16. Any waiver by Good Health of a breach of any provision of this Agreement shall not operate or be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or any other provision hereof. All waivers by Good Health shall be in writing.
17. This Agreement may only be modified in whole or in part by an instrument in writing signed by all the Parties.
18. In case any one or more of the provisions or parts of a provision contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or enforceability shall not affect any other provision or part of a provision of this Agreement, and this Agreement shall, to the fullest extent lawful, be reformed so that it would be valid, legal and enforceable to the maximum extent possible. Without limiting the foregoing, if any provision (or part of provision) contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be excessively broad as to duration, activity or subject, it shall be construed by limiting and reducing it so as to be enforceable to the fullest extent compatible with then existing applicable law.
19. Unless otherwise specifically provided, all notices required to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and in English and may be delivered personally, or may



be sent to e-mail, registered post or air mail, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:

20. This Agreement will be construed in accordance with and governed for all purposes by the laws of India and any disputes under this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at New Delhi.
21. Any failure by a party to perform its obligations under this Agreement shall be deemed to be a substantial breach, whereupon this Agreement may be terminated immediately by the other party, upon (a) written notice of at least 30 days to the breaching party and (b) such breach not being rectified by the breaching party within the notice period under due intimation to the other party.
22. The Provisions of clause 13, 14 and 15 of this Agreement shall survive the expiration of the Term or early termination of this Agreement. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreements, written or oral between and among Good Health, the Research Scientist and the Pharmacy College.



23. This Agreement will be executed in three counterparts each of which shall constitute an original and all of which are deemed to be a single agreement.

Department of Chemistry, University of Ulsan, located in Ulsan, SOUTH KOREA and Shree Dhanvantary Pharmacy College, Kim, Surat, Gujarat, India seek to implement opportunities for joint scholarship to facilitative academic co-operation; to develop research collaboration and to promote mutual understanding as well as applying joint research funds between the two countries. To these ends, the institutions agree to foster and promote academic co-operation in education and research between the two institutions. This *memorandum of understanding* (MOU) provides a general framework for the development of such collaboration including joint research projects between the two countries and holding of international seminars. A subsequent *implementation agreement* will specify institutional activities, which will be agreed upon and developed by Shree Dhanvantary Pharmacy College, Kim-Surat, India and Department of Chemistry, University of Ulsan, at a future date. This will include deputation of students for Ph.D training or post-doctoral research.

- I.
